24th Meeting on Signal Transduction from **November 15-17, 2021**
at the Leonardo Hotel Weimar.

The Meeting is planned as on-site meeting with a sophisticated hygiene concept. Specifically, the SARS-CoV-2 3G rules will be implemented, meaning that every participant must be vaccinated ("geimpft"), recovered ("genesen"), or tested ("getestet"). If you are neither vaccinated nor recovered, you will have to present a PCR or antigen test (max. 48 h old). Furthermore, the STS will provide antigen tests at the congress venue. Medical masks must be worn during the whole meeting unless you are sitting in the lecture hall (single seats only). Closely following the development of the SARS-CoV-2 pandemic, the STS council will stay in touch with the local authorities and will adapt the meeting organisation accordingly.
